Complete Birth Certificate, Delayed Birth Certificate, Doctor/Midwife Record, Church Record, Social Security Record, Family Bible

MARRIAGE

Complete Marriage Record, Marriage Bond/Bann, Divorce Record, Cemetery Record

DEATH

Complete Death Record, Cemetery/Tombstone (Photo), Church Record, Funeral Home Record, Insurance Policy, Family Bible.

CLASSIC SOURCES

Census – State, Federal Land/Deed Records, Military/Pension Records, Tax Records, Wills - County/State, School Record, Baptismal Certificate, Census Record, Church Marriage Certificate, Newspaper Announcement, Tombstone (Photograph), Family Bible, Church Record, Notice of Obituary, Mourning/Funeral Cards, Professional Organizations, Fraternal Organization Records, Probate Records, Bible and Family Records, Church Registers/Records or Encounters with the Law Histories (use with caution)

DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL PAPERS. Copies of all documented sources are required and will not be returned. If you send copies of pages from a published book be sure to submit a copy of the title page as further proof of your reference. On the reverse side of each paper submitted for documentation, please write your full name and that of your Forefather with the generation number for which it is intended. Upon acceptance, all papers will be attached to your application and stored in our files for future reference. The general public does not have open access to any of the applications or attachments.
